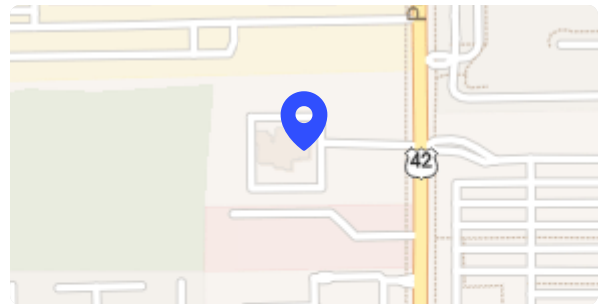

At the age of 20, he enlisted and served in the United States Navy from 1966-1970. 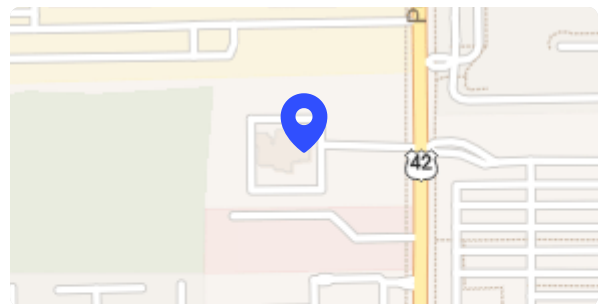

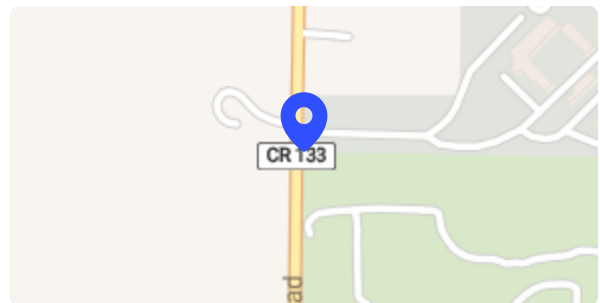
