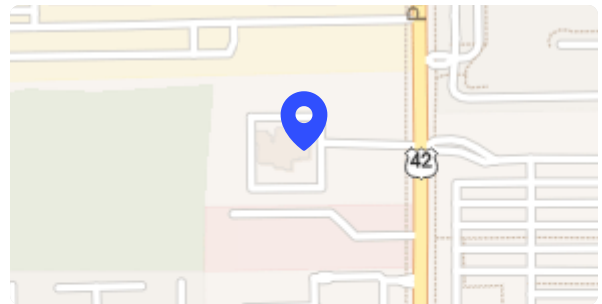
DEC 7, 1927 - JAN 21, 2019

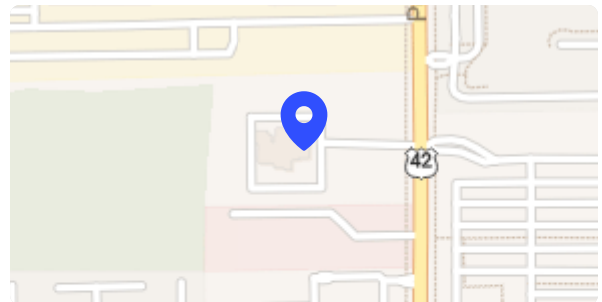

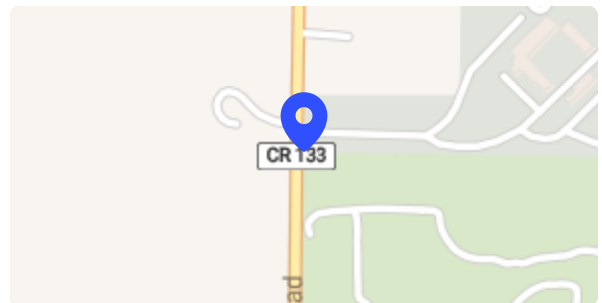
