In lieu of flowers, donations can be made to the Cuyahoga County Animal Shelter in her name.



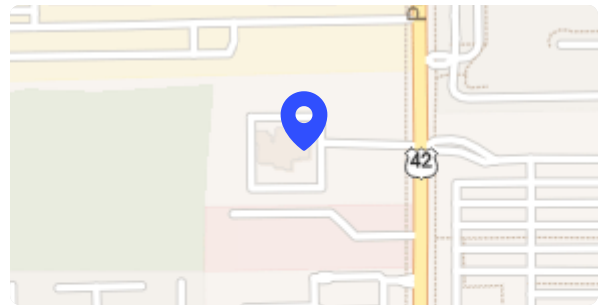

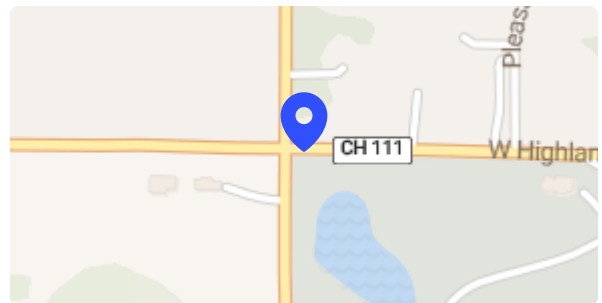
